## About the Society

Thank you for your interest in our Society. This leaflet, we hope, will answer your initial questions, and encourage you to come and visit our headquarters, Dean Hall. Apart from Bank Holidays Dean Hall is open from 2.00 pm to 4.30 pm and 7.30 pm to 10.30 pm on Mondays and Wednesdays and 7.30 pm to 9.30 pm on Thursdays.

In addition to our openings during the week, the Society has a more formal 'Monthly Meeting', which is held on the second Friday of the month at 7.30pm. In case of last minute changes details can be found in 'the Link' the Society journal and also on the mmrs.co.uk website. We have a programme of talks, demonstrations of modelling techniques and film shows geared to the interests of railway modellers and enthusiasts for the monthly meetings.

Layout construction is very much an ongoing activity at Dean Hall. We have groups modelling in 2mm N Gauge, Hazelwood Junction - in 4mm (18.83 gauge) Slattocks Junction - in 4mm OO Dewsbury Midland, and in 7mm O gauge the Mersey Division.



A 3.5mm scale H0 gauge American layout, Greenbrier Junction, has just been started. Measuring 18' x 2'6" This will interest people wishing to develop stock from the major

manufacturers. DCC operation.

Now in its fourth year, Canaan Valley, an end to end 7mm scale 16.5mm gauge (0n30) 18' x 2' layout running proprietary stock with an American image. DCC operation.

Our library is one of the most comprehensive collections of railway material in the country, and is available for reference and borrowing. We also have a collection of videos/dvd's, as well as magazines, plans and photographs.

Dean Hall accommodates a well equipped machine shop. Regular classes in the use of the machines are run by two of our members.

The society also organises a 'Running Session' usually in August and a Christmas Social for the December Meeting. Our Annual Exhibition is held at the Armitage Centre, Fallowfield, in early October.

All these activities are publicised in the Society's monthly 'in-house' journal "THE LINK" and on our website. The magazine also carries articles of general interest to the model railway enthusiast, notices of other specialist societies' meetings, some of which are held at Dean Hall, and is considered in the hobby to be a leading example of its type.

To complete our facilities, we have a fully fitted kitchen for tea, coffee and light refreshments. For the comfort of members the building is centrally heated.
