


# THE Christmas Model Railway Show - by public transport

By Tram: Take any tram which calls at Piccadilly Station (services 2, 3, 4 or 7).



## Services

- 1 — Altrincham – Bury
- 2 — Altrincham – Piccadilly
- 3 — Ashton-under-Lyne – Eccles
- 4 — Bury – Piccadilly
- 5 — East Didsbury – Rochdale Town Centre
- 6 — Manchester Airport – Victoria\*
- 7 — MediaCityUK – Etihad Campus

\* Early services operate on a 20 minute frequency between Manchester Airport and Deansgate-Castlefield. Please check journey planning posters or [tfgm.com](https://tfgm.com) before travelling.

On leaving the tram at Piccadilly station, (**NOT Piccadilly Gardens**) follow the signs for the **Fairfield Street** exit. Refer to the map on the next page where your route is marked in red.

As you exit the station, you will be near a busy cross-roads controlled by traffic lights. You need to cross to the opposite diagonal corner of this junction – aim for the **Bull's Head** public house, so cross London Road, then Fairfield Street, but leave the Bull's Head on your right as you walk on down London Road towards the railway viaduct about 50m away.

As soon as you walk under the railway viaduct, turn right into **Altrincham Street**. The Barnes Wallis building is about 80m ahead of you on your left. The entrance is marked by a statue of two interlinked red magnets and is approached by five steps, or a ramp, to a pedestrian bridge across a service road.

## By Bus

The exhibition venue is well served by buses. The nearest bus stops are shown on this map
